LAWS.

In answer to a question from a Wiltshire supporter—

A free kick is a kick allowed for a fair catch. It may be taken by a place kick, drop kick or punt. A free kick must be taken at or behind the mark on a line through the mark *parallel to the touch lines*; the kick must be taken by the player making the fair catch and the ball must reach a line through the mark *parallel to the goal lines* unless first played by an opponent.
