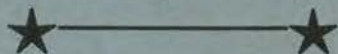

MOSELEY FROM 'BRUM'.

We welcome Moseley to-day and wish them a jolly good time on their Easter Tour. That they will have it is certain, for they are just the crowd to keep things lively. They have made Weston their headquarters and played there yesterday. They go on to Exeter for a game on Monday and stay at Stroud on their way home on Tuesday. According to their itinerary they have dinner booked for 8 p.m. at Weston this evening. Let's hope it is only a cold spread, so that nothing is cooked to death. Moseley are, of course, a very old established club and some sixty years ago—they have been running eighty one years—they were one of the best known clubs in the country. That was in the days of J. F. and F. A. Byrne, the former getting thirteen English caps and there were only three International games a season then.

We meet Moseley once a season only now and at the Reddings last April we just managed to win by 1 goal, 1 penalty goal to 2 penalty goals. Eric Hopton got the try and John Roberts the two goals. When they last visited the Rec. on April 19th, 1952 they set about us properly and won by 1 goal, 2 penalty goals, 2 tries 17 points to our try by Roberts, converted by Sullivan. Our team was Sullivan, Hambly, Hughes, Stevens, Addenbrooke, Weston, Halse, Roberts, Hill, Smith, Mattingly, Dingle, Todd, Hall and A. Lewis.

And we shall have to show better form than we did against Weston or Llanely, or Moseley are just as likely to repeat the dose.
