In the 1946-47 season Bath brought off the double and of course are one leg up this season and, while of course Bath are out to repeat the dose to-day, the Scots. are equally keen to prevent it which all means that we should have a hard, keen and most interesting game. If the weather be kind at long last and, at the time of writing there is every prospect that it may be, there are prospects that we may see scoring by the backs.
