LEICESTER NEWS

LEICESTER started the season with a very successful tour to Canada which culminated in a two-point defeat by British Columbia, to all intents the full Canadian national side. The home season started with comfortable wins against Bedford and Cardiff, but then a difficult period was encountered during the period of the World Cup and the Divisonal Championship and several games were narrowly lost. However, more recently results have improved and the side played well to defeat Wasps, Nottingham and Saracens in the League and to reach the next round of the Cup at the expense of Fylde.

EARLY EIGHTIES

Recent seasons have seen the retirement of several members of the very successful Leicester side of the early eighties. Players such as Dusty Hare, Paul Dodge, Les Cusworth, Steve Kenney and Ian Smith cannot be replaced overnight, but it is interesting that all of these ex-players

are involved in varying capacities on the coaching side of the Club and lan Smith is in fact the first team coach.

The Club is in good heart following the selection of Dean Richards, Neil Back and Rory Underwood for the senior England squad and six others as members of the development squad and it is around this group that the Club plans to build the next Leicester team. One member of the development squad is Gerry Ainscough, who joined the Club recently from Orrell. He is currently serving his qualifying period but will be available for today's game if selected. Also new to the Club this season is Steve Hackney who has made quite an impression since his move from Nottingham and seems to have revived his representative career. Back in the fold too, after his Cambridge experience is Tony Underwood and this will make for interesting selection discussions for the wing position.
