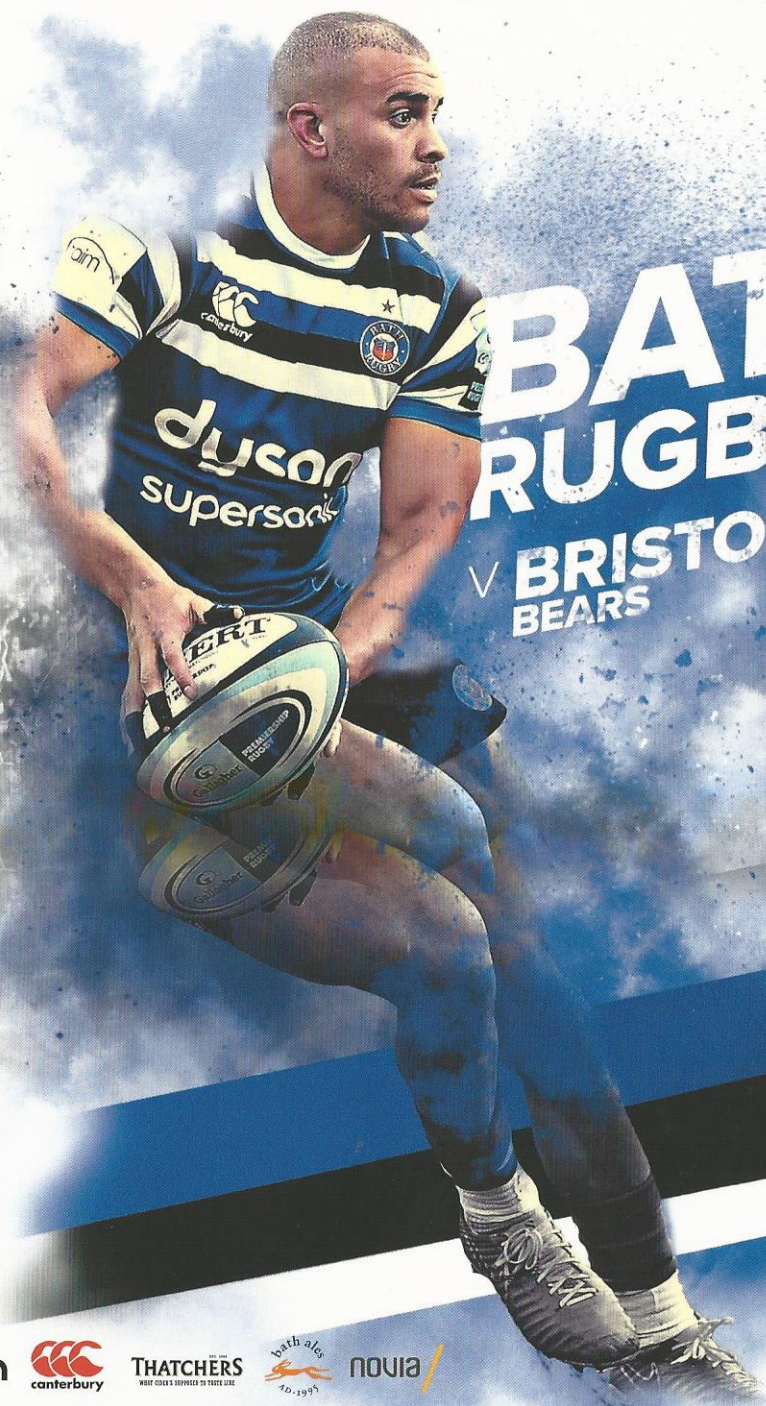

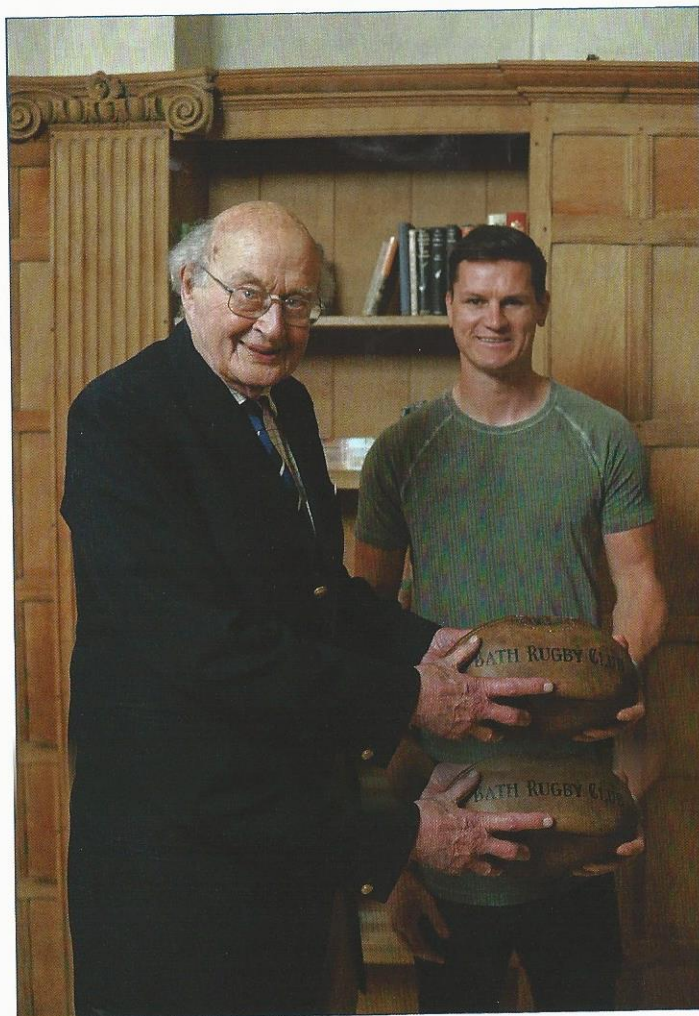
A TRIP DOWN MEMORY LANE WITH BATH'S OLDEST LIVING PLAYER
